The Thrift Shop of Aspen will only accept complete grant applications that are submitted no later than:

- January 15th (Presentations will be schedule for February-May)
- April 15th (Presentations will be scheduled for June-September)
- September 15th (Presentations will be schedule for October-January)

It is your responsibility to submit your application on time. We will not remind you.

Submittal Process

- 1. Title all documents you are sending to include the current year, organization name, & document title. Example: 2013-WeGiveInc-GrantApplication or (GrantReport, 501(c)(3)...)
- 2. Email all documents in 1 email.
- 3. Email: grants@aspenthriftshop.org
- 4. Subject of email: Your organization name & "Grant Packet"
- 5. Body of the email: Please include a list of the documents you have attached.

The preferred method is email. You can also fax the grant packet to: 1-888-583-8315.

After submittal of Grant Packet

- 1. You will hear from the Thrift Shop to schedule a presentation at the Aspen Elks Club, 3rd floor.
- 2. Prepare maximum 5 minute presentation plus a Q&A.
